The system can be applied to everyone who can make a sound out of their mouths. There are no music sheets, no compositions or structure to memorise and people don't have to sing properly. Any kind of voice is usable.

The focus is to explore sounds of human voice, but at the same time 'force' people to create experimental music, boost confidence, appreciate sound, and learn the process of spontaneous music creation.

Participants join a three-day Raung Jagat workshop, collaborating with sound, visual and performing artists as part of the larger EXQUISITE cumulative assembly work. They will the take part in a performance outcome as part of EXQUSITIE's Big Reveal. It is ideal for non-professional singers of any age, gender or personality.

Rully Shabara is the vocal front for *Senyawa* an Experimental Javanese Gospel group from Yogyakarta. *Senyawa* embodies the aural elements of Javanese music whilst exploring the framework of experimental music practice, pushing the boundaries of both traditions. Their music strikes a perfect balance between their avant-garde influences and cultural heritage to create truly contemporary Indonesian new music.
